We will be working with color, and experimenting with opaque, translucent, and transparent applications of paint. With fluid acrylics and heavy-bodied acrylics, we will create a variety of textured surfaces with varying degrees of transparency. We will work with watercolors in the morning session and acrylic in the afternoon. You will leave the workshop with two of your own authentic works of art. Lessons learned throughout the day can be applied to classroom instruction.
