Purpose	The purpose of this training is to provide participants with the knowledge and skills needed to conduct effective resource mapping at their local sites. The actual mapping of your school's resources does not take place during the training session.  Resource mapping is a component of the REACh Framework/school planning process, and enables educators to coordinate resources to most effectively respond to the learning needs of students. Participants will be introduced to activities in the four stages of the Resource Mapping process: pre-mapping, mapping; strategic implementation, and evaluation. Participants will leave with the tools and strategies needed for working as a professional learning community to conduct effective resource mapping.
