Purpose: To expose students with and without disabilities to local businesses where they might seek employment, while also exposing as many businesses as possible to students who want to work.

Description: Students will describe their visions for their futures, then go into the community for an “Amazing Race.” Amazing race is a fun and effective way to connect with employers while building student confidence and communication skills.

Activities: Students break into small groups of 3-4 with an adult chaperone. They then go into the community and compete to see who can approach the most employers and gather the most business cards and job applications. The teams also ask questions at each business. They then return at a set time to meet to tally scores, give awards and share information.
