S.M.A.R.T. Program Presentation

S.M.A.R.T. (Stimulating Maturity through Accelerated Readiness Training) is a developmental approach to teaching that takes advantage of current brain research. It focuses on stimulation of the brain stem versus the brain cortex, the area where most curricula is focused. In fact, most curricula assume the brain is fully prepared to learn once a child arrives at the doorstep of school. However, for a number of reasons, that's often not the case.
