Workshop Learning Objectives

- Increased understanding of the CCR-IEP 5 Step Process from the lens of related service providers (focus on steps 1 & 2).
- Increased understanding of how related service providers can support reading outcomes as well as options for supporting reading for students identified with a speech/language impairment.
- Application of Steps 1 and 2 of the Five Step Process to support teams in developing IEPs designed to improve access, engagement, and progress for students.
- Identify strategies to use in preparing for and participating in IEP team meetings, including ways in which related services providers can support IEP team discussions.
