- Increased understanding of the CCR-IEP 5 Step Process from the lens of early learning, with a focus on steps 1 and 2.
- Application of Steps 1 and 2 of the Five Step Process to support teams in developing IEPs designed to improve access, engagement, and progress for students.
- Use WI Model Early Learning Standards to understand present levels and consider IEPs and best practices for students ages 3-6. Develop early learning standards based IEP and integrate Indicators 6 & 7. Use age anchoring tools, practice writing functional goals and early literacy in IEP
