

VAPING VIOLATIONS

A Pupil Service Staff Training



In July 2019, CESA 10 received an AODA grant from the Department of Public Instruction to address e-cigarette usage and prevention efforts in schools. CESA 10, in partnership with the Chippewa County Health Department, utilized these funds to create a training program with a social-emotional learning approach to students who violate their school's vaping policy.

This two-day training will focus on the decision-making process that led a student to vape, rather than the discipline that occurred as a result of it. Training participants will also learn how to use cognitive behavioral therapy and personality tests to gauge how students will react in certain situations. Grant funds will cover all training and material costs for this unique opportunity.
