



## Training Calendar (Updated 8/26/19)

College and Career Ready (CCR) IEPs, is the Wisconsin DPI framework for IEP development for students aged 3 through 21. This full day workshop provides an overview of the CCR IEP Five Beliefs and CCR IEP Five Step Process to support IEP teams in the development of Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) that improve a student’s access, engagement, and progress in age/grade level standards, curriculum, instruction, and environments.

Participants are strongly encouraged to attend in groups of at least two from the same district. Each participant must bring a copy of a student’s IEP\* to use as reference or have access to an IEP online to use during the training.
