Workshop Description:

Presenters: Two Trainers Certified in Youth Mental Health First Aid

This workshop is designed for adults working with youth ages 12-20 who are experiencing a mental health, addiction challenges, or is in crisis. It is good for teachers, administrators, aides, bus drivers, office support staff, Boys and Girls Club, etc. to attend. It would be a review, to some degree, for pupil services staff.

YMHFA is an eight-hour workshop led by 2 trained instructors. Material will cover information on mental health literacy, adolescent development, anti-stigma messaging and a five-step process to support youth with a mental health crisis and suicidality. Participants will learn the signs of a mental health crisis and have the information to refer to outside resources.

The YMHFA training manual will be included with the course.
