Career Pathways in K12 are realized through each district’s Academic and Career Planning process. A career pathway is developed, implemented and maintained in partnership among secondary and postsecondary education, business, and employers. A career pathway is available to all students and designed to lead through the desired levels of education and training to rewarding careers. There are eight requirements for a state endorsed pathway to be developed:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Employer Led and Collaborative</li><li>2. Labor Market Information Driven</li><li>3. Sequence of Courses</li><li>4. Work Based Learning</li><li>5. Industry Credential</li><li>6. College Credit</li><li>7. Included as part of ACP delivery</li><li>8. Equity and access for ALL students</li></ol> <p>This workshop will provide your team with the resources and tools to complete your district pathways.</p>
