



Phonemic Assessment for Students who are Non-Verbal and/or Students with Cognitive Disabilities

September 15, 2011

Assessing the phonemic awareness of students who are non-verbal or who have cognitive disabilities can be difficult. This session will help you to understand how to assess one of the building blocks for developing readers-phonemic discrimination (hearing the different between sounds or phonemes). This session will help teachers identify key literacy development stages and assess students (even those with severe physical & speech impairments) for phonemic and literacy development using the adapted phonemic assessment.

Participants will develop their own classroom assessment kit. Participants will receive an adapted phonemic assessment PowerPoint on a CD, literacy assessment forms, and start to create their own adapted phonemic assessment kit. The CD will allow teachers to evaluate their students using the computer as an interface for those students who needs are best met through that media. Additionally participants will create a more traditional paper based kit and should bring their own scissors or paper cutter.
