

# SUBSTITUTE TEACHER TRAINING

CESA 9 developed the Substitute Teacher Training in response to a Legislative Bill which permits the temporary teacher certification of individuals with an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in areas other than education. Our training, held at CESA 9 in Tomahawk, is designed to prepare prospective substitute teachers with in-depth information about the substitute's role. Participants who complete the training and practice will receive a certificate of completion. During the workshop, participants will be guided through the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's application process for the Substitute Teacher License.



## Benefits of our two-day training:

- Ability to identify and understand the professional responsibilities and roles of a substitute teacher.
- Ability to identify and demonstrate successful classroom organization, management, and behavioral strategies.
- Understand the importance of student safety.
- Able to prepare and conduct a lesson.
- Understand the legal responsibilities of a substitute teacher.
- Ability to use and demonstrate appropriate communication protocols and procedures during the school day.

Veterans will receive \$100 off the registration fee with a valid military ID! Simply note that you are a veteran in your registration and bypass the payment screen. We will adjust pricing after an ID is presented on the first day of the workshop.
