Workshop. It's targeted for the busy classroom teachers who want to skip some of the strategy of blended learning and jump straight to practice implementation steps. Helping teachers replace traditional top down teacher led instruction with more student centered learning.

Workshop Objectives:

- Teachers will experience blended learning models of delivery.
 - This starts with a flipped classroom model by completing 2 hours of pre-work online
 - Station rotation (using break out rooms) and
 - Flex models of blended learning with built in choice
- Teachers will experience an introduction to student-centered learning.

- Teachers will dive into a Student Experience Project.
- Teachers will learn the secrets of a successful culture.
