**DESCRIPTION:** The art of storytelling will serve as our medium to learn about the language and cultures of our multilingual students and their families.

This 6- book series builds educators awareness for supporting linguistically and culturally diverse learners and aligns with culturally responsive teaching standards for speakers of other languages.

- The books have been chosen for their ease of access for busy educators and include the voices and perspectives of authors who have lived these experiences.
- A collection of resources will accompany each book. These collections will include poems, essays, articles, data, podcasts, videos and materials for classroom use.
