DESCRIPTION: ISTE Certification for Educators is a new competency-based, device-neutral teacher certification based on the ISTE Standards for Educators. This digital credential recognizes educators who understand how to use edtech for learning in meaningful and transformative ways. Through the ISTE Certification process, teachers will participate in professional learning that will support any learning environment: face-to-face, hybrid, or remote. After completing the training, participants have six months to apply their learning and compile artifacts and reflections into a competency-based portfolio to earn ISTE Certification.
