





- Social distancing expectations
- Engaging in Covid-sensitive behaviors as part of an aggressive stance (eg. spitting at someone)
- Anxiety and/or trauma-related reactions to the situation


### THIS WORKSHOP WILL EXPLORE THESE ISSUES ALONG WITH:

Dr. Richard Van Acker

Dr. Richard Van Acker is an emeritus professor of special education at the University of Illinois-Chicago. His research explores the development and treatment of antisocial behavior in children and school-based intervention with students who present emotional, behavioral, and mental health disorders. Rick actively consults with school districts across the nation and serves as a special consultant with the school boards of seven states. His



work has been presented in over 100 published articles, monographs, book chapters and books.
