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TOPIC	
The first session will address the basic requirements for districts to address Homelessness. In addition, your questions will be addressed to provide guidance to staff in addressing the need of the youth and families in their community. DPI staff will participate to support schools in addressing Homeless issues in their district.	
During this session, will continue the discussion on homeless issues for schools and communities we work with. The school is often the "central institution" in the community. What are the requirements that schools need to be looking to address? How can we work with community agencies and resources to meet the needs of the students in our schools.?
