Terrance M. Scott is a Professor and Distinguished University Scholar in the College of Education and Human Development at the University of Louisville and is Director of the Center for Instructional and Behavioral Research in Schools (CIBRS). His research interests focus on schoolwide prevention systems, the role of instructional variables in managing



student behavior, functional behavior assessment/intervention, and scientific research in education. He is a former counselor and teacher to students with behavioral disorders and since receiving his Ph.D. at the University of Oregon in 1994, he has successfully competed for more than \$24 million in grant funding, has more than 100 publications - including four books, and has conducted well over 1000 presentations and training activities throughout the U.S. and around the world.
