Overview Agenda

The Leadership Center has created the "Leading for the Future" program as an opportunity for all building level administrators to become part of a network of educational leaders. The "Leading for the Future" program will provide building level administrators with an opportunity to come together to discuss relevant, timely administrative issues; to provide each administrator with enhanced leadership knowledge, skills and abilities; and to bestow upon each administrator a greater

understanding of the roles and responsibilities

associated with central administrative

positions and the District Administrator.

Each of the five sessions will run from 8:45-11:45 am. This will allow the building administrators to begin their day in the building, come to the leadership session, and return in time for the noon-hour activities. Sessions will be conducted in Oshkosh. The dates are:

September 29, 2009, LaSure's Banquet Hall; November 10,2009, LaSure's Banquet Hall; January 12, 2010, Location TBD; March 9, 2010, LaSure's Banquet Hall; May 11, 2010, Lasure's Banquet Hall.

Cost: The cost for an administrator to participate in "The Leading for the Future" program for the 2009-2010 school year will be \$125.00.

Graduate Credit will be offered through UW-Oshkosh for this program. One credit will be available for \$200. Sign up for graduate credit will take place the first session.

Each session will include the following components:

Welcome and Introductions

-Begin to know one another.

The Administrator's Quandary or From the World of the Strange and Bizarre

- Participants of the program will be presented with unique real-life and possibly bizarre educational issues to discuss and identify steps that effective leaders would have taken in addressing these issues. Participants will also have the opportunity to present and discuss leadership issues that they are presently dealing with within their educational setting.

Technology and the Effective Leader

- The CESA 6 Technology team will introduce and highlight effective usage of technology that educators should be using to enhance student and staff learning.

The Hot Topic

- A timely, relevant, and hot educational topic will be presented. Participants will then have an opportunity to discuss the impact of this issue on their building and how they believe effective leaders would or should address this issue.

The Law and the Administrator

- At each of the five sessions, Jim Macy or one of his colleagues from the Davis and Kuelthau Law Office will briefly present a legal issue and discuss the legal ramifications for building administrators.

Leadership Topic of the Day

-Each "Leading for the Future" session will have a leadership topic that is timely and relevant to building-level administrators. Educators from surrounding school districts will be invited to our session to lead this discussion and group discussions related to the topic will follow.
