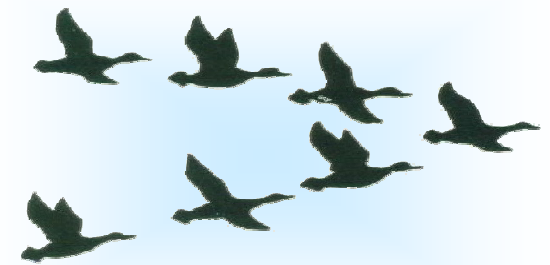

Overview

“The Leadership Journey: Developing a Culture of Leaders” is a six (6) session leadership development opportunity being sponsored by the CESA 6 Leadership Center. This program will provide each participant with an opportunity to enhance his/her leadership knowledge, skills, and abilities; to obtain an understanding of his/her personal leadership philosophy and style, as well as identifying how he/she can move toward the formulation of an organization of leaders; to discuss timely and relevant leadership issues with colleagues; and to obtain insights regarding effective leadership from leaders in the fields of business, industry, government, and higher education. This program is truly an opportunity for each participant to improve his/her ability and effectiveness as an educational leader. This leadership development program is open to all educators who seek to improve their effectiveness as an educational leader. New administrators, educators being groomed for future administrative roles, or teacher leaders who may be new to leadership roles are especially encouraged to participate in this program.

Each year, those engaging in the Leadership Journey will work toward the fulfillment of a new Leadership Goal. In 2009-2010 participants will develop a working definition for the concept of educational leadership.

- **Welcome and Introductions**
 - Identify who is on our bus.
- **What is Educational Leadership?**
 - Teams of educators will be created to develop a working definition for the concept of educational leadership.
- **Creating Leadership to Lead**
 - This portion of the agenda will focus on assisting each educator in obtaining a better understanding of the concept of leadership as it exists in an educational setting.
- **Effective Leadership and You**
 - Educators on the journey will have an opportunity to learn about their personal leadership philosophy, style, and ability to lead.
- **Leading today for a Better Tomorrow**
 - This portion of your journey will provide you with the opportunity to raise and discuss real-life leadership issues that you are facing in your educational setting.
- **Leadership Beyond K-12 Education**
 - You will have the opportunity to meet and learn about leadership from individuals who are engaged in leadership roles outside the area of K-12 education and also receive their message to us as educational leaders.
