

# DPI Sponsors PDP Review Team Training for CESA #3

## **CESA #3 will host a DPI training for Professional Development Plan Team Reviewers on Friday, November 11, 2011**

We are seeing growth in the numbers of Initial Educators coming into CESA #3 school districts each year. This equates to an increasing need for veteran/professional educators to serve on the PDP Review Teams for these new teachers who are required to receive their ongoing teacher certification through the Wisconsin PI-34 Teacher Certification Process. Initial educators need a PDP Review Team consisting of an administrator, a veteran teacher and a higher education representative.

To be a Professional Development Plan (PDP) Team member on an initial or professional educators team, you need to complete a DPI-sponsored training. The training has two components. The first is an on-line PI-34 PDP Module, which includes a self-assessment. Upon completing this module, you will be asked to print a verification certification. The second component is registration and participation in a one-day DPI PDP Team Training such as this event. This event is free of charge.

Each participant will need to complete the on-line PI-34 PDP self-assessment module. The goal of the module is to provide the background knowledge of PI-34 so they may better understand the context within which the PDP process emerged. Further, this knowledge will allow them to participate fully in the training. First, view the PowerPoint. Then, complete the self-assessment. Print the certificate and then they should bring it with them to the training to be listed on our website as a trained PDP Team member.

The address is <http://dpi.wi.gov/tepd/pdptrain.html> then click on "On-line PI-34 PDP Module." When you log on to the module, it will ask you for your six-digit license number. If you do not have a WI educator license, Higher Education participants for example, you will need to use 000000 in place of the six-digit license number.

Initial Educators who do not hold a professional license can attend a training, but cannot be listed on the DPI website as a trained team member. Once they apply for their professional license, they can then send in their team member form and include the date they were trained.
