

Substitute Teacher Training

CESA 9 developed the Substitute Teacher Training in response to a Legislative Bill which permits the temporary teacher certification of individuals with an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in areas other than education. Our training, held at CESA 9 in Tomahawk, is designed to prepare prospective substitute teachers with in-depth information about the substitute's role. Participants who complete the training and practice will receive a certificate of completion. During the workshop, participants will be guided through the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's application process for the Substitute Teacher License.
