Learners will focus on building their skills in restorative practice technique of formal conferencing. This is a technique used to repair harm and in lieu of punitive discipline instead focusing on building communication and problem solving skills.</p> <p>Learners will be able to use formal conferencing as a Tier 3 technique in their work with students to repair and build relationships with adults and peers.</p> <p>This training is meant for district teams or individuals to attend to enhance their knowledge of Formal Conferencing and build their own capacity to lead this work.</p> |
