

Course 1: Multisyllabic Word Reading for Struggling Readers, Grades 3+

Participants will learn a flexible decoding strategy for teaching multisyllabic words. Students need to internalize this word-solving strategy in order to read grade-level text with accuracy and understanding. Participants will learn the direct instruction methodology and will leave with knowledge and skills to implement the strategy.

Reading Intervention Workshops



Learn how to unlock the magic of reading for your struggling students. All three of these workshops are designed for teachers who work with struggling readers in grades 3-8+. They will empower teachers with high-impact, evidenced-aligned teaching practices. These strategies can be used with or without a program, though specific recommendations will be made.

Course 2: Corrective Reading Decoding B1, B2 & C, Grades 3+

Corrective Reading is an evidence-aligned, research-validated reading intervention for students in grades 3-12 who are reading well below grade level. It is an accelerated remedial reading program designed to address both the academic and the social-emotional issues faced by older students who are struggling to learn to read. There are 4 levels to the Decoding strand of Corrective Reading, A, B1, B2, and C. Each of these levels includes targeted word work; story reading for accuracy, fluency, and comprehension; and guided workbook activities that require students to remember and apply taught concepts. A program-specific placement test determines which level is most appropriate for a student. Teachers attending this session will learn the teaching techniques needed to successfully implement the program for Levels B1, B2 & C. Due to the unique nature of the lowest level, Corrective Reading Decoding Level A, a half-day workshop will be held on August 13 (see session #3). It is recommended that participants attend both days.

Course 3: Corrective Reading Decoding A, Grades 3+

Corrective Reading is an evidence-aligned, research-validated reading intervention for students in grades 3-12 who are reading well below grade level. A program-specific placement test determines which level is most appropriate for a student. Generally, students in mid-grade 3 and above reading between non-reader and 2nd-grade level place into Decoding A, the lowest of the 4 levels. This level is 65 lessons long and can be completed in a semester with daily instruction between 30 and 45 minutes. Much like a prescription from the doctor, it is necessary to continue in the Corrective Reading Series through at least Decoding B2 for students to make the most gains. Therefore, it is highly recommended that teachers attend BOTH Corrective Reading Decoding sessions on Aug 12 and 13.
