INITIAL EDUCATORS

Each session engages the learner by modeling active engagement strategies, exploring ways to meet the needs of all learners, and providing opportunities to collaborate with experts in the field. Participants will build a strong personalized learning network with other new teachers that provides support. Also, participants will receive a copy of "Management in the Active Classroom," a valuable tool for building a strong SEL-focused classroom culture.
