**Description:** **School-Wide Positive Behavior Supports (SW-PBS)** is a proactive systems approach for creating and maintaining safe and effective learning environments in schools, and ensuring that all students have the social/emotional skills needed to ensure their success at school and beyond.

By creating a Behavioral Intervention Plan (BIP) based on a function-based behavioral assessment, teams will learn how to use data for decision making and ongoing progress monitoring. Teams will develop an action plan for the development of a system for the how and when of conducting FBA/BIPs.

**Registration fee:** \$700 for a school-based team of 6 individuals or less, includes food, beverages, snacks & facilities charge. *Additional team members may attend the training for \$100 per person per day.*
