Years Two/Three Initial Educators Support Seminar Series 2021-2022

Four beginning teacher support seminars, designed to assist districts in meeting the PI 34.040 [5] district requirement of ongoing orientation, are offered in a combination of in-person and virtual formats this year. Meetings are held quarterly throughout the 2021-22 school year. These initial Educator Seminars provide professional development, opportunity for discussion, and a community of practice amongst beginning teachers throughout the CESA 12 region. Each meeting is tailored to the needs of beginning teachers. Seminars feature instructionally-focused outcomes, exploration of the related Framework for Teaching (Fft) Components, and an aligned mentor supplement resource to encourage continued professional development of both the beginning teacher and mentor.
