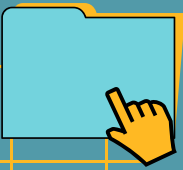
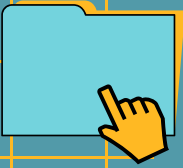


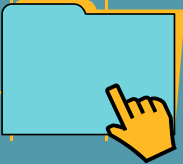
WHAT IS SCRIPT AND WHY DO WE NEED COMPUTER SCIENCE FOR ALL STUDENTS?
