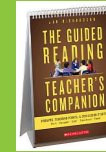

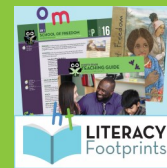

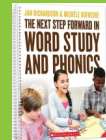
The Next Step Forward in Guided Reading uses an Assess-Decide-
