## What is **CS4ALL** and **SCRIPTS**:

The **Strategic Computer Science for ALL Resource & Implementation Planning Tool**—is a framework to guide district teams through a series of collaborative visioning, self-assessment, and goal-setting exercises to create or expand upon a computer science education implementation plan for their students.



## CESA #5 CSforALL Network

The CS4ALL Network will comprise both existing CS4ALL/SCRIPTS trained districts, as well as districts seeking to receive training and/or offering Digital Technology regional career pathways, CS4ALL is for District/Building Leadership, such as administrators, coaches, curriculum directors and computer science teachers. CS4ALL is designed to implement knowledge, skills, and applications related to CS, and digital technologies are implemented across the system.

- Identify barriers that districts are challenged with so that we can address them
- Apply continuous improvement to identify where future CS4ALL cohorts/workshops can proactively address identified needs
