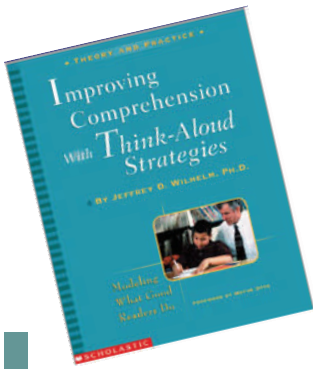

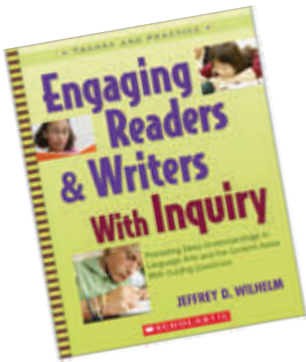
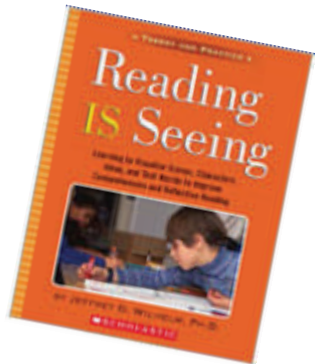
Teaching Engaged and Reflective Reading with Adolescents
