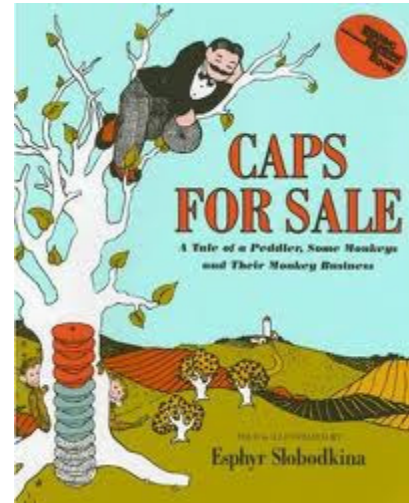


“Using Storytelling and Puppetry with Young Children to Enhance Learning”
