This training is designed to leverage the impact district and school teams have as they implement equitable, multi-level systems of supports in behavior (PBIS), reading, and/or math. Class activities include presentation of theory, reading, discussion, group and partner work, modeling and demonstration, reflection, and practice and feedback.
