About the ACT Assessment

The ACT Assessment is a standardized college entrance examination that measures knowledge and skills in English, mathematics, reading and writing, and science reasoning as well as the application of these skills to future academic tasks. The ACT consists of four multiple-choice tests and an optional writing test.

- ENGLISH = 75 questions in 45 min.
- MATH = 60 questions in 60 min.
- READING = 40 questions in 35 min.
- SCIENCE = 40 questions in 35 min.
- 40 min. WRITING TEST (optional, depending upon where the student applies to college)

ALL JUNIORS in WISCONSIN are REQUIRED to take the ACT+Writing exam for FREE on March 7, 2023, at each public high school.
