PURPOSE

ADOS-2 Administration and coding are highly standardized. Therefore, valid assessment requires a trained and clinically experienced examiner.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Each two-day workshop covers use of ADOS-2, how to administer and score it, and general diagnostic issues. An experienced workshop leader describes the ADOS-2 and demonstrates administration and scoring, operationalizing diagnostic criteria for ASD. You'll have the opportunity to practice scoring while observing an instructor administer the ADOS-2 to a child with ASD. The workshop focuses primarily on Modules 1 through 4 as well as the Toddler Module.
