In collaboration with CESA's 7, 8, and 9 we are pleased to announce that Wiley Blevins will be back with a Multisyllabic Words class in January.

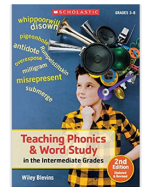

The needs of students below grade-level expectations will also be addressed.
