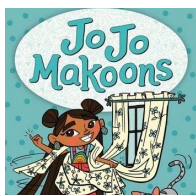


*Individuals may only register for ONE of the three Online Study Circles Conversations for Spring 2023.

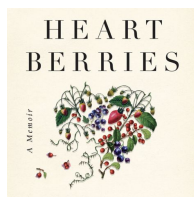
