<b>Aperture Education- DESSA</b>	Directly aligned to the CASEL™ framework, the DESSA is a nationally standardized, strength-based behavior rating scale that assesses students' social and emotional competence with editions that support students K-12. It has been used by districts and out-of-school time programs across the country to support social and emotional learning.
<b>Education Elements- Tripod</b>	Tripod helps schools listen to students and all of the school community by providing validated and research backed survey instruments to provide pathways for everyone to communicate directly with education leaders about what they are experiencing. We offer three surveys which focus on student classroom experience, SEL, and DEI.
<b>Fastbridge SAEBERS</b>	The SAEBRS (Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Risk Screener) is a brief, norm-referenced tool for screening all students to identify those who are at risk for social-emotional behavior (SEB) problems. SAEBRS is one of the only SEB universal screening tools built to assess both the absence of problem behaviors and symptomatology (e.g., internalizing and externalizing behaviors) and the presence of well-being and competencies (e.g., social-emotional skills). SAEBRS has a student-rater companion assessment, mySAEBRS, which allows students in grades 2-12 to self-assess their social, academic, and emotional behavior.
<b>Gain Instruments- GAIN-SS</b>	The GAIN-SS is a screener to be used in general populations to quickly and accurately identify clients who would be flagged as having one or more behavioral health disorders on the GAIN-I.
<b>Intellispark</b>	As part of the Intellispark System, the ScholarCentric assessment is a comprehensive, evidence-based resiliency solution based on more than a decade of research by Professor V. Scott Solberg of Boston University's Wheelock College of Education & Human Development. The Six Resiliency Skills measured by ScholarCentric include: valuing education, academic confidence, health and wellbeing, stress management, connectedness, and intrinsic motivation. Studies clearly demonstrate that students who are exposed to ScholarCentric achieve greater academic success – including improved attendance, higher grades, more earned credits, and higher levels of resiliency.
