

WISCONSIN ALTERNATE ASSESSMENT FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES TRAINING

During the 2009-2010 school year, the **Wisconsin Alternate Assessment for Students** with **Disabilities** will be administered during the same testing window as the WKCE. Special education teachers, who are required to administer the WAA-SwD, must complete training in order to administer this assessment correctly.

Three half-day training sessions are being offered for special education teachers who will be administering the WAA-SwD for the first time. Special education teachers who would benefit from an opportunity to attend another training session are also invited to attend. Teachers will be introduced to the Wisconsin Extended Grade Band Standards and Performance Descriptors. They will also learn the procedures that must be followed for the administration of the Wisconsin Alternate Assessment for Students with Disabilities.
