In this series, participants will learn about the progression of early numeracy and number relationships necessary to help build their students' number sense. Participants will also learn developmentally appropriate strategies and routines for supporting students' number sense that can easily be implemented in any elementary classroom. Many of these activities can also serve as "sponge activities" that soak up those in-between minutes of the school day when students transition from one activity to the next so that educators can make the most of every minute of the school day.
