

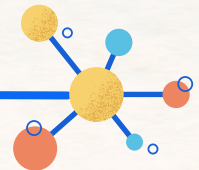
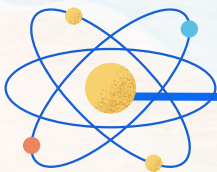
Science Educator Network
