

School-Based Suicide Prevention Training March 27, 2012

Wisconsin's youth suicide rate is consistently among the highest in the nation. We lose an average of one young person age 10-19 every 10 days to suicide; it is the second leading cause of death, and accounts for almost 1 in 5 of all deaths among Wisconsin youth. The most recent multi-year analysis of national data (CDC, 1999-2007) puts Wisconsin's rate 14

State law requires school districts to provide specific classroom instruction in youth suicide prevention, and to annually notify staff about DPI's resources.

This workshop is not intended to train all school staff, but prepares teams of pupil services staff, health educators, and administrators to plan, prevent, and intervene at their schools. Action planning is integrated into all phases of the training program. A CD-ROM with complete program materials and a model workshop for all school staff are provided. This workshop helps you understand the scope of youth suicide and what schools can do to reduce suicidal acts and thoughts among students.

Participants will learn about:

- The prevalence of youth suicide
- Risk and protective factors
- Comprehensive prevention programs, and
- Crisis intervention

In addition, we will:

- Discuss the state requirements
- Help you gain new knowledge and skills to improve classroom instruction at the middle- and high-school level,
- Participate in authentic, performance-based assessments—strategies to help students understand suicide and demonstrate their knowledge
