You are receiving this email because you are a Cooperative Educational Service Agency (CESA) administrator or a licensed speech-language pathologist. Your email address was obtained from the CESA website or your employers' website. This study is about motor speech intervention in pediatric therapy. The main objective of this study is to evaluate speech-language pathologists' 1) perceptions of benefits and disadvantages of oral motor exercises (OMEs) and nonspeech oral motor exercises (NSOMEs), 2) use of different types of nonspeech oral motor exercises, and 3) for what client/patient conditions speech-language pathologists would use oral motor exercises and nonspeech oral motor exercises.
