



## Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) -Refresher Training

This training will be a Refresher Training for those who have previously completed a Crisis Prevention Initial Training.

The Nonviolent Crisis Intervention® Training Program is a holistic behavior management system based on the philosophy of providing the best Care, Welfare, Safety, and Security for staff and those in their care even during the most violent moments. The program focuses on preventing disruptive behavior by communicating with individuals respectfully and with concern for their well-being. The program teaches physical interventions only as a last resort - when an individual presents an imminent danger to self or others - and all physical interventions taught are designed to be non-harmful, noninvasive, and to maintain the individual's dignity. Follow-up debriefing strategies are also key components of the training program.

Participants will be required to complete an online training portion before attending the in-person training. Participants will receive information about the online training 1-2 weeks prior to the in-person training date.

Cost: \$121.99 per person (\$75 registration fee + \$46.99 for online modules, participant workbook)
