

# Social Emotional Behavior Collaborative Series

Focus on the strategies, interventions, and system structures for students who need additional support related to social-emotional learning, mental health, trauma, and neurodiversity, all of which can be activators for challenges with regulation, sensory processing, and executive functioning skills. Participants will engage in shared learning in topics related to supporting students with the above needs and/or missing skills through an asset-based lens. Topics addressed will include:

- System lens to implementing tiered systems of supports
- Effective data collection and monitoring for SEL and behavior supports (aligned with eligibility requirements)
- Tools, strategies, and interventions that support the success of some of our most unsettled students
- Facilitated Networking Opportunities

## Outcomes

Support for those who are implementing social-emotional student support teams and processes:

- Strengthen ability to identify underlying causes/missing skills to strategies and interventions that support growth and learning
- Increase the implementation of evidence-based strategies within systems
- Increase capacity of staff and systems
- Student-specific IEP, FBA/BIP implementation
