### iPads for Special Education

The iPad changes the way teachers and students access the web, share media, and learn on the go. This workshop will be broken up into an AM session and a PM session. During the AM session Eric Larsen and Kaye Lietz will present iPad basics including “must see” apps and websites for all educators. During the PM session participants will work in small job specific groups to explore and share “job specific” apps and other uses of the iPad to enhance learning for your specific students. Work groups will be divided into the following categories: Cross-Categorical, Autism, VI, DHH, Speech/Language, and OT/PT. **Hurry—This Class is almost full.**

### iPads for PK – 5, 6-12th<sup>th</sup> Grade Teachers

We will also take a look at apps that we can possibly develop ourselves. The day will include plenty of hands-on time.

### Reaching the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learner

Current students are digital natives, so they instantly connect to technology. This helps them relate to the content of the message since they already connect to the medium of the message. Create a classroom project that will connect to your 21<sup>st</sup> Century students using tools and topics including: Edmodo, podcasting, wikis, and Prezi. Time will be provided to explore the tools demonstrated. By the end of the workshop you will have created a complete, working project that can be used yet this school year.

### Using SMART Boards in Classrooms

(PK-5th and 6th-12th Grade Classrooms)

In these workshops, you will learn how to use SMART Notebook™ software to create a presentation that's rich with graphic detail and how to use SMART Board™ tools to quickly access functions that help you operate the interactive whiteboard more effectively. Activities appropriate for PK – 5<sup>th</sup> or 6-12th grade will be highlighted.
