The purpose of this two-day training is to provide a systematic approach to recognizing and assessing individuals in the academic environment who are using and are impaired by drugs, in order to provide early intervention. The subject matter presented touches upon some, but not all of, the factors a Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) considers when examining a drug-impaired individual.

## The training will cover:

- Definition of "drug"
- Concept of drugs that impair in the academic environment
- Drug choice within a community
- Role of divided attention tests in assessing impairment
- Observable effects of each of the seven drug categories
- Observable effects of various drug combinations
- Medical conditions that appear similar to drug impairment
- Appropriate procedures for dealing with drug impaired or medically impaired individuals
- Importance of policies and procedures for dealing with drug impaired individuals in the academic environment
- The assessment process
