Participants will have the opportunity to examine their own teaching through the CCSS lens and determine next steps in the unwrapping process as well as implementing the CCSS into their teaching.

- understand how to apply standards vertically and horizontally across grades
- leave with a method for unwrapping the standards

The sessions will also provide information about the Smarter Balanced Assessment system that will come out in 2014-2015. Sessions are led by expert area content specialists.
