Objectives

Teams will develop a district plan for PBIS implementation and sustainability, self-assess the systems necessary for capacity building, professional development and sustainability, action plan around identified financial resources, personnel time commitment, and other district specific needs, including coordination/braiding with other district initiatives.

Target Audience

Districts that have already attended Administrative Overview and have buy-in from their district. Teams of 6-8 people should be formed and should include: **District Administrators** (Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Special Education Director), Building Administrators, School board member, Parent Representative, Teacher, Internal and External Coaches. Note: This is not a day intended for school level training or planning.

Preparation

Participants should bring district-wide data such as:

- ⇒ District-wide ODR data per day per month, by race/ethnicity, special ed. Status; additionally schools may want to refer to:
 - Suspension/expulsions, Detentions
 - Attendance data
 - Academic data including State testing scores
 - Special education referral rates, Educational Environment rates
 - Dropout rates and Graduation rates
 - Office Discipline Referral Data with Ethnicity percentages and referrals to alternative schools
