### A LOOK AT ASSESSMENT TOOLS FOR CHILD OUTCOMES

**WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:** Using an assessment tool to guide the rating of a child for Indicator 7 Child Outcomes work is critical to ensure an accurate, quality rating. In this 1/2 day mini-workshop we will briefly review types and purposes of assessment tools used in early learning settings. Then, we will explore in more detail several criterion-referenced tools currently being used in Wisconsin for ongoing assessment including the New Portage Guide, Teaching Strategies GOLD, and the AEPS (Assessment, Evaluation, & Programming System for Infants and Children).
